1. The State of Ohio *requires* fifty (50) hours of driving (ten [10] hours at night) during the term of the Temporary Permit and that said Permit be held for a minimum of six (6) months. It is in the best interest of the student's driving that this be completed. The closer to fifty (50) hours that can be attained, the better *drive-rite's* efforts to turn out a safe low-risk driver will be. If it is determined, by the Certified Instructor/Trainer that the student does not exhibit, at minimum, fifteen to twenty hours (15 – 20) of experience before beginning training with said *drive-rite* Instructor/Trainer, the parent will be ask to wait until the student's performance reflects such driving time.
2. Behind-the-Wheel training is a partnership between the student, the parent and *drive-rite*. What this time reflects and does (see above) is give the student driver a 'frame of reference' upon which to professionally build with a *drive-rite* Instructor/Trainer.
3. When a *drive-rite* Instructor/Trainer arrives for pick-up, the student MUST have their Temporary Permit in their possession or the appointment will be cancelled and a Forty (\$40.00) dollar NO SHOW Fee will be assessed with all future behind-the-wheel sessions being cancelled until payment is received.
4. Please do NOT schedule the Skills Test with the State of Ohio until the Certificate of Completion is received or picked-up at *drive-rite*. We commit to having the Certificate ready for pick-up between three and five (3 – 5) days after completion of the *drive-rite* program.
5. Weather Alert: If Fairfield City Schools cancels class, classes at *drive-rite* may also be cancelled. Behind-the-Wheels may also be cancelled (the decision is up to the Instructor/Trainer, previous experience behind-the-wheel and the number of previous behind-the-wheels with a *drive-rite* Instructor/Trainer. You can find our status on Channels 5, 9 and/or 12.
6. If the *drive-rite* Instructor/Trainer is late for a session, please allow fifteen (15) minutes before contacting our office (513) 939-1222. At times, traffic conditions and previous student parental conferences may delay pick-up.
